Proficiency Enrollment

Once a student has completed a pro ciency in a sub ect area with a satisfactory grade, he she may not tale a lower prociency level in that subject area. For example A student cannot enroll in English 00 = 00 / after having successfully completed English 110 = 110/. This does not apply to vocational refresher courses.

Cheating and Plagiarism

Dishonesty in the classroom is considered a very serious o ense. Any form of cheating, turning in wor which is not one s own plagiarism, is grounds for disciplinary action. The consequences of these actions are severe and may include the possibility of expulsion.

Grading System

rades are based upon the quality of wor done that is, upon actual accomplishment in courses o ered for credit. rades are issued at the end of each term.

The total number of units earned for courses in which a student has earned a grade of A is multiplied by 4. The same type of calculation is done for units earned of , C, D, and F. The grade point average is then calculated by dividing the total number of grade points earned by the total number of units attempted in which grades of A, , C, D, and F were assigned.

rades for repeated courses will be included or excluded as indicated

In calculating students' degree applicable grade point averages, grades earned in non-degree applicable courses shall not be included.
