DearDr. Garcia:

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The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges, at its meeting January 13-15, 2021, reviewed the Follow-Up Report and related evidentiary materials submitted by Imperial Valley College purpose of this review was to determine whether the College has appropriately responded to the issues as identified by the peer review team at the time of the last visit and as expressed in the Commission's Action Letter of June 28, 2019, and whether the College monstrated compliance with the related Standards.

Upon consideration of the information noted above, the Commission finds the fial Valley Collegehas addressed opliance Requirement 1, corrected deficiencies, and meets Standard B.2, II.A.3, and II.B.3. The Commission further finds continued non-compliance with Standards I.B.7 and I.B.9 (Compliance Requirement 2), and acted to grant a Good Cause Extension The College is required to submit a Follow Report by November 1, 2021, which will be followed by a visit from paer review team The Follow-Up Report should address the remaining deficiencies noted in Compliance Requirement 2. The accredited status of the institution continues during the good cause extension period.

The Commission requires the College to disseminate this FollowReport, and this letter within the institution, including by posting them on the College's website. The Commission looks forward to receiving the College's second Follow-Up Report to address the deficiencies. The Commission has granted as much time as allowable under Federal regulations and will be obligated to take an adverse action if the Standards are not met.
