7. How many units do I need to transfer?

You will achieve full junior standing when you have completed 60 transferable semester units. If you wish to transfer as a lower division student, the university will consider your high school record in determining whether to admit you. The University of California requires 60 UC-transferable semester units for upper division transfer. Some UC campuses infrequently accept students as lower division transfers. The California State University currently grants junior standing at 56 semester units (but not for financial aid or scholarship purposes). Effective Fall 2005, CSU will require 60 CSU-transferable semester units for junior transfer. Some CSU campuses are open to lower division transfers, but grant them lower priority for admission. Independent and out-of-state universities often accept students with fewer than 60 semester units. Please check the printed or online catalog for the specific university to which you want to transfer for their requirements. An IVC counselor can assist you with that.
