8. If I earn an Associate degree, will I be prepared to transfer?

Generally, meeting the requirements for an Associate degree will not prepare you for transfer admissions. Not all courses that are counted toward an Associate degree are accepted for transfer and General Education requirements differ, as well. (See "What is General Education (GE)" below.) However, it is possible to earn an IVC Associate degree by completing 60 Associate degree units and fulfilling all of the GE requirements for transfer.
